For every day that your child reads, have them color a beach ball on their reading log. Bring the completed reading log on the first day of school. Students entering first through third grade should practice their sight words daily in addition to reading.

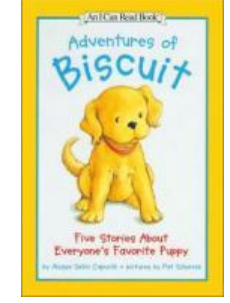
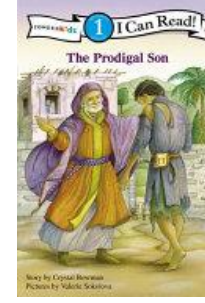
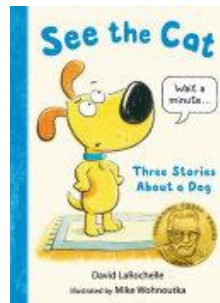
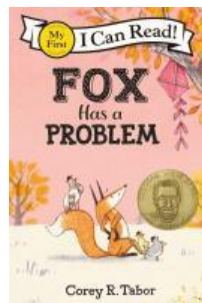
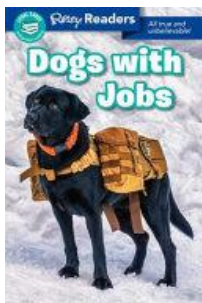
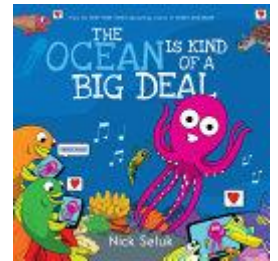
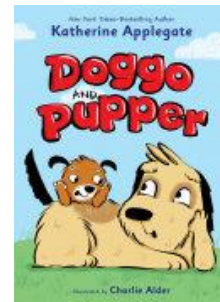
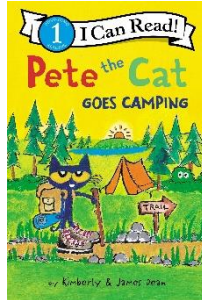
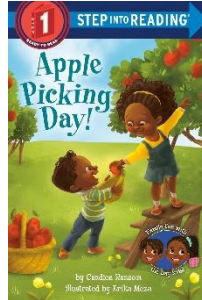
